Trivia Questions from Stories of the Hebrew Bible

- 1. What is the Hebrew Bible or the Tanakh (tə-nach) known as in Christianity? the Old or Older Testament
- 2. What the concept of believing in one God called? What is the concept of believing in multiple gods called? *Monotheism; polytheism*
- 3. What is a special and powerful promise of trust and relationship called? Covenant
- 4. Which two biblical figures are most famous for making a covenant with God? Noah and Abraham
- 5. Which woman in the bible receives a promise directly from God? Hagar (Sarah and Abraham's enslaved handmaid)
- 6. Which Jewish prophet asked Pharoah to free the Israelites from Egypt, to "let his people go?" *Moses*
- 7. With what did Moses come back from Mount Sinai to find his people worshiping a golden calf? *the Ten Commandments or the Decalogue*
- 8. What is the practice of debating and resolving problems posed by difficult passages of the Hebrew Bible? (Hint: the Hebrew term for rabbinic literature that contains interpretations and commentaries on scripture.) *Midrash*
- 9. Which queen was secretly Jewish and risked her life to stop a plot to destroy all the Jews? *Queen Esther*
- 10. Why did most people believe that David could not defeat Goliath? What did David use to defeat Goliath? Because he was young, "just a boy"; a sling shot
- 11. Why was Daniel cast into the den of lions and what is the miracle he is known for? For praying to Yahweh/the God of the Jews; surviving, not being eaten by lions
- 12. What scientific phenomenon explains how two objects on opposite ends of the universe are connected and impact one another? *Quantum mechanics or quantum connections*

- 13. What are images of biblical figures or narrative called? *Icons*
- 14. What term does "speaking truth to power" and "being visionary" define? Prophetic/prophetic imagination

- 15. Many of the stories in the Hebrew Bible are about families and lineages.
 - a. Who is the son of Sarah and Abraham? Isaac
 - b. Who are the twin sons of Isaac? Jacob and Esau
